3) Approve meeting Minutes from June 16, 2017:

4) Community Energy Dashboard Presentation:

Rob Fish showed us the website. Will fix the differentiation between Barre City and Town. Encouraged us to get our own log-ins with passwords once corrected.

Reminded us that when looking at energy, we don't just focus on electricity, but all the means by which we can improve. People learn in different ways, therefore, this website if very visually appetizing, both with graphics and stories of real work completed in municipalities in the State. Think of the website as a newspaper: stores are those above the fold, and the informational links at the bottom like the editorials. This is a collaborative effort among many entities, sharing data across wide boards. Information can be manipulated, revised, uploaded and downloaded, printed.

Phil asked about the progress vs goal statistics, Rob stated data is from the LEAP model. The Atlas gives a real-location visual as to where energy improvement work is occurring. Elaine asked about goals by average size of improvement. Phil talked about weatherization and what Capstone works on, and could that information be captured as well. Hoping to post between 2 and 5 success stories for Barre City, will work with Kate until she leaves her post, but the new Americorps staff will take over once installed.

We will leave this on the agenda going forward to keep working on it.

5) Heritage Festival Proposed Budget
