Naming November 1, 2021 "Extra Mile Day"

• BARRE ROTARY CLUB — Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Rotary Club shifted away from its usual activities by offering opportunities for community members to come together in safe, socially-distant ways. They provided frequent drive-in movies projected on the outside wall of the local skating fieldhouse, where families could get out for an evening's entertainment while remaining safely in their own vehicles. The Rotarians also established the Barre Art Splash, with art installations displayed along Main Street all summer long. Members of the public could walk along and view the displays out in the open air. Both offerings allowed people to reengage as a community while remaining safe during these extraordinary and trying times.
