


# CITY OF BARRE, VERMONT MAYORAL PROCLAMATION

## A PROCLAMATION FOR CAPS4COPS DAY

- WHEREAS, in 2018 “Caps4Cops” was created, taking used bottle caps, recycling them and using the money to educate the public about the Police Officers who go above and beyond the badge and showing their accomplishments; and
- WHEREAS, Caps4Cops wants to reward Police Officers who go above and beyond for their communities, showing them that people care and see the good that they do; and
- WHEREAS, Over the past year Caps4Cops and Jason Gould have taken the Caps4Cops idea and expanded it as an organized scrap metal fundraiser where people can donate any scrap metal at one giant collection point in Barre City, helping Vermonters have a place to dispose of items twice annually; and
- WHEREAS, The Caps4Cops team has created a full spectrum event helping Vermonters save money, as they would have to pay to dispose of items, helping the environment by recycling all the metal filling several large containers, and then taking profits from metal to invest into bridging the divide between Citizens and the Police; and
- WHEREAS, in 2020, Police Officer Jason Gould has again partnered with Caps4Cops and Buldoc’s Salvage Yard to create a scrap metal fundraiser utilizing one collection point next to the Auditorium in the City of Barre.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that I, Lucas J. Herring, Mayor of the City of Barre, Vermont, do hereby proclaim May 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2020, as Caps4Cops Day in the City of Barre and encourage residents to take advantage of the event to recycle metal items and recognize the positive impact made by Law Enforcement in our community.
