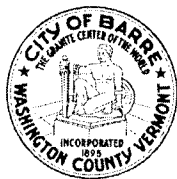

**Regular Meeting of the Barre City Council
Held June 29, 2021**

The Regular Meeting of the Barre City Council was called to order in person and via video platform by Mayor Lucas Herring at 7:00 PM at Barre City Hall. In attendance, participating in person, or by video or phone, were: From Ward I, Councilors Emel Cambel and Jake Hemmerick; from Ward II, Councilors Michael Boutin and Teddy Waszazak; and from Ward III, Councilors Ericka Reil and Samn Stockwell. City staff members present via video or phone were City Manager Steve Mackenzie, Fire Chief Doug Brent, Deputy Fire Chief Joe Aldsworth, and Clerk/Treasurer Carol Dawes.

Absent: NONE

Adjustments to the Agenda: There was discussion on the consent agenda item to approve the purchase of the bola wrap restraint device, and it was noted the purchase falls within the Manager's spending limit under the procurement policy. The Manager said he included it in the consent agenda so the Council and public would have information about what actions the police department is taking.

Approval of Consent Agenda:

Council approved the following consent agenda items on motion of Councilor Boutin, seconded by Councilor Waszazak. **Motion carried.**

The City Clerk/Treasurer Report –

Clerk/Treasurer Dawes reported on the following:

- Water/sewer bills are due by June 30th.
- Today was the hearing in the Judd v. City of Barre election challenge case. The court ruled in the City's favor.

Liquor Control – Council approved an extended outside consumption permit for The Quarry Kitchen & Spirits to close off the Depot for July 23rd and July 24th on motion of Councilor Waszazak, seconded by Councilor Reil. **Motion carried with Councilor Boutin abstaining.**

Council approved a Special Event Permit application for Lawson's Finest Liquids LLC out of Waitsfield for a malt tasting at Mr. J's on July 16th from 3-6PM on motion of Councilor Stockwell, seconded by Councilor Waszazak. **Motion carried with Councilor Boutin abstaining.**

City Manager's Report - Manager Mackenzie noted his written weekly report included in the Council packet. Councilor Hemmerick asked for an update on submission of a road grant to the state, the storm water permits applications, and repairs and clean-up following a vehicle accident on lower Camp Street over the weekend. Manager Mackenzie said he'll look into them.

Visitors and Communications –

Fire Chief Doug Brent asked for clarification on the use of the two donations received from the Hollow Inn, and noted the minutes from last week's meeting indicated the donations will be used for the summer community picnic. Chief Brent asked that the Fire Department's donation be allocated to the Department to use for the purchase of unbudgeted equipment. Council approved allocating the FD donation as requested by the Chief, and allocating the Police Department donation to the summer picnic on motion of Councilor Stockwell, seconded by Councilor Cambel. **Motion carried.**

Resident Bernadette Rose read the following statement:

Thank you All, for making Council and Committee Meetings hybrid, continuing to provide me and others with access. Being able to connect via ZOOM has given many of us older citizens and citizens with disabilities an opportunity to actively engage in our City Governance.

Hybrid meetings allow me to participate more fully as a member of the ADA Committee as well. I am able to safely meet along with those for whom meeting in person is better. It is a win-win.

Having been a parent, I imagine the great benefit of access for people with young children, for working people, for fostering greater accessibility, as well as holding open and transparent meetings.

I am hard pressed to understand why anyone would find fault with your decision to make meetings at City Hall fully accessible with the modest investment in technology to do so. For this reason, I want to go on record as fully supporting the decision to keep the remote part of the meeting accessible, so ALL citizens in Barre can participate remotely or in person.

Old Business –

A) Reschedule Grand List Workshop.

Council requested the workshop canceled earlier this month be rescheduled for this fall. Clerk Dawes will be in touch with District Advisor Barbara Schlesinger to set up another date.

New Business –

A) Update from the Vermont Granite Museum.

Granite Museum executive director Scott McLaughlin said the museum weathered the pandemic pretty well, but the number of volunteers has dropped. He is working with various organizations on building up the volunteer corps through work-based training initiatives. They held a soft opening in May, and have been open five days/week through June. They'll be open six days/week beginning in July. Requests are coming in to rent the space for meetings and special events.

Their focus this year is on five areas:

1. Support for the stone arts school,
2. Archive the building,
3. Hire a curator of collections and exhibits,
4. Create the sculpture park,
5. Make historic Barre Granite Association and Rock of Ages films available to the public. They have received a National Film Preservation Foundation grant to make this happen.

VGM board member Peter Anthony said Mr. Maclaughlin has helped improve the profile of the museum and the community through his efforts.

B) CVHHH & Barre City EMS Dept. Community Collaboration Program.

Central Vermont Home Health & Hospice CEO Sandy Rouse said they have been on the front lines since the beginning of the COVID pandemic providing services in the field. Ms. Rouse said they have been partnering with Barre City's Emergency Medical Services, and Deputy Fire Chief Joe Aldsworth was named Community Partner of the Year for his assistance in enhancing care. Dep. Chief Aldsworth said it's a team effort with the entire public safety department including EMS, fire and police, the mental health clinician, and the community services interventionist. Fire Chief Doug Brent said the City benefits from the great relationships between all the partners. Councilors gave Dep. Chief Aldsworth a well-deserved round of applause.

C) Overview of ARPA Funding Program and Approval of Grant Terms & Conditions.

Manager Mackenzie reviewed the terms and conditions associated with acceptance of the federal American Rescue Plan Act funding. Council approved the following motion made by Councilor Boutin, seconded by Councilor Stockwell. **Motion carried.**

Motion to certify that the Barre City Council agrees to the Treasury Department's ARPA Funding Terms and Conditions, and to appoint the City Manager as the Authorized Representative for the grant administration, and requests the disbursement of ARPA funds to the City.

D) Discussion of Ordinance Review Process in FY22.

i. Administrative Ordinance.

Mayor Herring reviewed the process and the cover memo he prepared for review of the administrative ordinance. There was discussion on what ordinances might need reviewing, the purpose and process for review, and meshing reviews of ordinances with reviews of charter to make sure language and content is consistent and accurate. Council gave unofficial approval to the process.

E) Assignment of Ordinances for review in FY22.

Mayor Herring said he will continue to work on the administrative ordinance. There was continuing discussion on purpose and process, and use of staff time. Ordinances on the Council FY22 priority list will be sent to designated staff members for review as their schedule allows.

F) Appointment of Charter Work Group.

Councilors Reil and Stockwell were appointed to serve on the charter work group with Clerk Dawes on motion of Councilor Cambel, seconded by Councilor Waszazak. **Motion carried.**

G) Discussion of Policy Review Process in FY22.

Mayor Herring went over the list of policies still to be reviewed. It was suggested a policy be developed on the timeline and development of the capital improvement plan, to serve as a guiding document.

H) Review and Approval of FY22 Council Priorities.

Mayor Herring reviewed the list. There was discussion on the possible development of a PILOT program for properties owned by non-profits; reviewing trends in the grand list, budgets, deferred maintenance, costs to maintain services and building infrastructure; and tying priorities to goals. The PILOT priority item was moved from the FY22 priority list to FY23.

I) Athena Leadership and Young Professionals Nominations.

Mayor Herring spoke of soliciting nominations, which should be received by August 1st to allow for

submission by the September 1st deadline. Councilor Boutin said he will be nominating Barre Partnership executive director Tracie Lewis.

Round Table –

Councilors wished everyone a happy July 4th.

Councilor Cambel said upon hearing the report from CVHHH, she is amazed and grateful for the work being done in the community.

Councilor Waszazak said tomorrow is the last day of Pride Month, and wished everyone a happy Pride Month. He said most City staff members work under the radar every day, but the work is vitally important to the success of the City.

Councilor Stockwell said she found Canales Park, and noted it's a wonderful asset for the community.

Councilor Hemmerick said how nice it is to be meeting in person again.

Mayor Herring said Sunday's ribbon cutting and re-opening at the municipal pool was great.

The meeting adjourned at 8:58 PM on motion of Councilor Boutin, seconded by Councilor Cambel.

**VERMONT WARRANTY DEED
(PERPETUAL EASEMENTS)**

KNOW ALL PERSONS BY THESE PRESENTS THAT, METRO 159, LLC, Grantor, a Vermont Limited Liability Company, of the City of Barre, in the County of Washington, in the State of Vermont, in the consideration of **TEN DOLLARS AND OTHER GOOD AND VALUABLE CONSIDERATION**, paid to its full satisfaction by the **CITY OF BARRE, Grantee**, a municipality having its situs in the county of Washington and State of Vermont, by these presents, do freely give, grant, convey and confirm unto the said **Grantee, CITY OF BARRE**, a municipality having its situs in the county of Washington and State of Vermont its successors and assigns, forever, **a permanent and perpetual easement** over and across a part of the lands of Grantor located in the City of Barre, in the County of Washington, and State of Vermont, described as follows, viz:

Being a permanent and perpetual easement within a strip of land approximately twenty-seven feet (27') in width and approximately fifty-four feet (54') long, to construct, maintain, repair parking spaces, a public use walk way and a public access to the City public parking lot the location of which shall be as presently improved and constructed by the City of Barre, Vermont, now constituted on part of the easterly side of Grantor's property described hereunder.

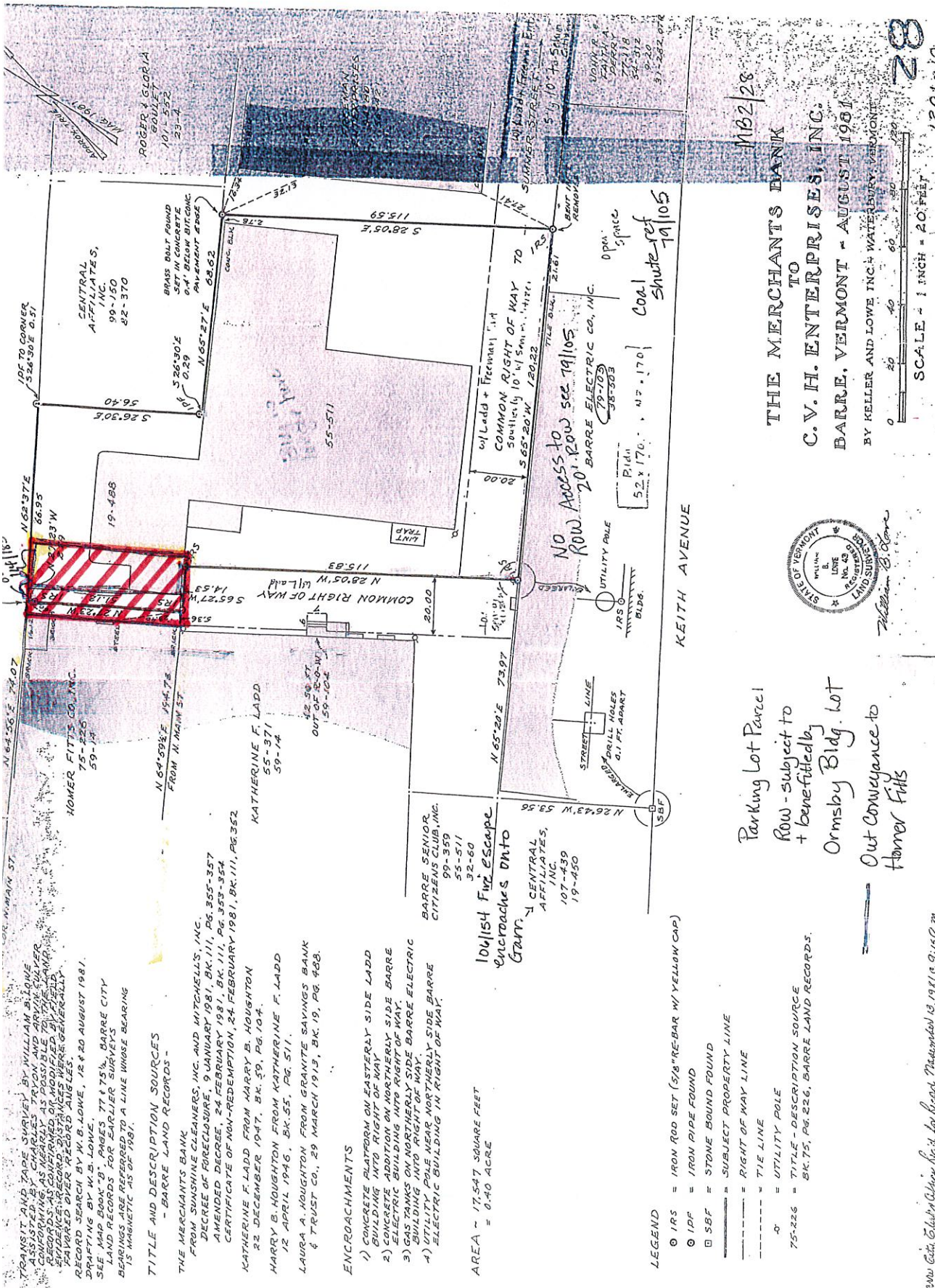

In advance of my scheduled visit with the Barre City Council on Tuesday, July 13, here is a summary of topics for discussion.

1. Introduction, CVSWMD Overview

As a union municipality with 18 member cities and towns, the Central Vermont Solid Waste Management District (CVSWMD) provides valuable waste management programs and services to its member municipalities to assist with proper waste disposal and waste reduction.

CVSWMD Serves Member Towns in several ways:

- State required administration, reporting, monitoring, ACT 148 and Materials Management Plan Implementation, and outreach
- Testify at the statehouse on solid waste issues
- Public education about solid waste laws
- Offers municipal, school, and organizational grant funding
- Additional Recyclables Collection Center (ARCC)
- Household Hazardous Waste Collection Program
- School Zero Waste Programming
- Hauler licensing and enforcement
- Print and online materials with a waste-reduction focus
- Technical assistance: workshops, presentations, events about all aspects of waste management, Act 148 requirements
- Sale of equipment at reduces rates to help residents manage food scraps
- Solid waste planning to meet all of the State of Vermont's requirements: SWIP

CVSWMD is currently implementing a USDA Grant in Barre City that allows for additional assistance to landlords of multi-unit housing to manage their food scraps in the form of free equipment like kitchen food scrap pails, recycling bins, safe and secure compost equipment and enclosures, as well as training to landlords and tenants. More than 28 Barre City properties have already received benefits; interested landlords should reach out to us by September 1st.

2. Financial Picture

The CVSWMD final budget for FY22 is set at \$1.169 million, a 7% reduction from FY21. In FY21, CVSWMD's Board of Supervisors reduced the municipal per-capita assessment by \$.50 (from \$1) in recognition of the fiscal challenges faced by member municipalities. To offset the

reduction in FY210, there was an offset in grants offered to municipalities, schools and businesses. In FY22, the per-capita assessment returns to \$1.

3. *Response to Covid-19*

After closing our administrative office for more than a year, we have reopened to the public with pre-pandemic hours of operation. The ARCC has been fully operational since July 1, 2020 and is accepting all materials: paint, batteries, bulbs, computer/TVs, electronics, food scraps, tires, propane tanks, air conditioners, and dozens of other items. Our outreach and education team is preparing to resume work in the community and in schools, and are working closely with administrative personnel to be sure that any and all Covid-19 safety protocols are followed.

We are offering curbside sales of compost equipment to residents by appointment at the ARCC in Barre City. Our website includes a link to learn more and sign up.

4. *New or Pending Legislation*

A number of new bills were introduced but were not considered, and no new laws related to solid waste were passed this legislative session. One bill that would expand the current “bottle bill” was introduced and passed the House. It is slated to be taken up again in January when the legislature convenes:

H 175 - An Act Relating to The Beverage Container Redemption System

This bill expands the beverage container deposit-redemption system to include water bottles, wine bottles, and other containers.

Two collections within the district are scheduled this season and are open to all residents in CVSWMD’s district:

- August 14, Bradford Town Garage, 359 Fairground Road
- September 25, Montpelier - VT Dept of Labor, 5 Green Mountain Drive

6. *CVSWMD’s Plan for a Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Facility*

Attached you will find an information sheet about the HHW facility project, which highlights current activities.

In June of 2020, CVSWMD provided information to the Barre City Council about the planned HHW permanent facility within our District.

- Background:
 - CVSWMD residents have consistently expressed the need for a year-round Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) drop-off center.
 - Vermont’s Universal Recycling Law (Act 148) and the Vermont Materials Management Plan (MMP) impose requirements that are best met through a permanent facility for HHW.
- Benefits:

1. Having a permanent, year-round drop off site for Household Hazardous Waste means hazardous materials are more likely to stay out of the landfill.
 2. A year-round facility means residents and businesses will have convenient services when they need them.
- Cost - Total cost is expected to be \$1.8 million
 1. \$500,000 from ANR
 2. \$594,400 committed from CVSWMD reserve funds
 3. Unsecured funds to be filled through grants, CVSWMD reserves, or other non-bond sources
 - Potential Location – Barre City, Montpelier, Berlin, East Montpelier area
 - Schedule to open if a site is secured this year: fall of 2022

Why a new HHW facility for Central Vermont Solid Waste Management District?

Safe, convenient, timely collection of Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)

CVSWMD residents have consistently expressed the need for a year-round Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) drop-off center in Central Vermont. In addition, Vermont's Universal Recycling Law (Act 148) and the Vermont Materials Management Plan (MMP) impose requirements that are best met through a permanent facility.

There are two main benefits:

1. A permanent, year-round drop off site means hazardous materials are more likely to stay out of the landfill.
2. A year-round facility means residents and small businesses will have convenient services when they need them.

CVSWMD offers five, one-day HHW collections per year throughout our 19 member towns. Currently, residents may only drop off household hazardous materials in Central Vermont during those five collections. If people cannot attend those dates, materials must be stored until the next year's collections or transported to other regions of the state where a facility exists. This has proven particularly problematic for residents cleaning out property belonging to family members or others who have moved and left materials behind.

CVSWMD has received significant funding for a HHW Facility.

In 2020, CVSWMD received a \$500,000 grant from the State of Vermont Agency of Natural Resources to construct a facility for HHW collections. In 2021, CVSWMD received an additional ANR grant of \$100,000. The State's support for this project emerges from a 2017 report highlighting a permanent HHW facility as critical infrastructure missing in central Vermont.

The CVSWMD Board of Supervisors has approved use of \$594,000 in district funds that have been saved and allocated for this project over many years. We recognize that, even with grant funding and the amount dedicated to the project, additional resources will be needed. CVSWMD has applied for additional grants, and intends to use internal financial resources if needed. We do not expect to pursue external bond financing for this project.

CVSWMD is poised to move forward with construction of a HHW Facility.

CVSWMD has assembled a team consisting of a solid waste facility designer, project manager and engineering firm, and the District is currently negotiating a contract with a design-build firm. We are poised for facility construction to begin as early as spring 2022, or as soon as a site is acquired and State and local permits in place.

Our goal is to purchase property for the facility in the Barre-Montpelier-Berlin area, although other locations will be considered. We are seeking approximately 5 acres (but as many as 8-10 acres), which will enable CVSWMD to expand operations in the future. The stability of owning property and a facility gives CVSWMD flexibility to meet the demands of volatile recyclables markets and evolving environmental regulatory standards.

Key site features are convenience to service customers, site host community considerations, avoidance of sensitive natural resource areas such as floodplains or wetlands, and proximity with waste handling or other complementary activities.

CVSWMD intends to operate the new facility two days per week on a year-round basis, then consider expanding hours depending on demand and available resources. Small businesses (Conditionally Exempt Generators) will be accommodated by appointment.

Currently the district collects many of Vermont's "Extended Producer Responsibility" (EPR) materials such as paint, fluorescent bulbs, e-waste, and batteries, as well as food scraps and many other hard-to-recycle items at our Additional Recyclables Collection Center (ARCC) in Barre City. Future plans may include relocating the Additional Recyclables Collection Center to the HHW facility location.

Resolution #2021-11

RESOLUTION RELATING TO REDUCTIONS IN THE MOTEL HOUSING PROGRAM

- Whereas*, changes in the motel housing program have increased the number of state residents without access to shelter, potable water, and sanitary facilities as the state begins to merger from pandemic; and
- Whereas*, the end of the eviction moratorium will add to the number of people without shelter; and
- Whereas*, the state has insufficient rental housing, emergency shelters, and transitional housing now and for the foreseeable future; and
- Whereas*, the lack of shelter, water and sanitation imperil the health & well-being of unsheltered residents; and
- Whereas*, many individuals in low wage employment live close to the brink of homelessness and are often food insecure; and
- Whereas*, individuals in low wage employment may be paying for heat in uninsulated buildings, adding to their potential inability to afford rent; and
- Whereas*, minimum wage has not kept pace with cost of living and no individual making minimum wage can afford the cost of a one-bedroom apartment; and
- Whereas*, individuals in low-wage employment have few benefits and protections, or access to affordable child care and individuals in low-wage employment may not have predictable number of hours or a predictable schedule, further adding to housing insecurity; and
- Whereas*, individuals in countries with higher levels of income inequality experience higher rates of mental illness; and
- Whereas*, ‘deaths of despair’ include economic hardship as a cause and include deaths by overdose and suicide; and
- Whereas*, this represents a statewide crisis of resources beyond the scope of the municipalities; and
- Whereas*, we are a state that has demonstrated the capacity to organize and mobilize resources for the safety and well-being of its citizens; and
- Whereas*, it is within state statute that the Department of Health be involved in plans for developing appropriate shelters; now therefore be it resolved that
- No therefore be it resolved that we, the BARRE CITY COUNCIL, BARRE, VERMONT*, do hereby ask that the state continue to exhibit the same level of care and planning that we experienced during the pandemic in creating a new plan to reduce the Motel Housing Program. We respectfully request the Governor to reconvene the house and senate and to request the Joint Fiscal Committee, in conjunction with the department of health, develop a state plan that would:
- Define adequate shelter and access to water and sanitation; and

Provide for the construction of shelter and access to water and sanitation sufficient to cover the number of individuals without housing; and

Mobilize private and public resources not excluding private developers, mobile home and motor home vendors, manufacturers of housing kits, yurts, tiny homes and related suppliers and owners of abandoned housing and unused factories to ensure adequate shelter and to do so with urgency.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Barre City Council supports the creation of a new state plan for the reduction of the Motel Housing Program in Vermont as soon as possible and urges the Governor and his administration to announce a date for reconvening the needed parties.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council requests the City Clerk to send a copy of this resolution to the Governor, the Secretary of Human Services, and the Commissioner of Health.

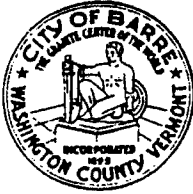

In order to keep you informed of the Department activities of the office, I'm forwarding this report of activities of the City staff for the previous Friday - Thursday. If there are any additional questions please do not hesitate to ask.

1. CLERK/TREASURER'S OFFICE:

- Continuing discussions with the State Auditor's Office on the TIF audit. Expect the final document to be released next week.
- Board of Abatement hearings scheduled for July 29th. There are 10 hearings scheduled: five from individuals and 5 from the City.
- Grievance hearings began on July 8th. At the completion of the grievance hearings, decisions will be mailed out, and the final grand list will be lodged, after which the municipal tax rate can be calculated. The Council is scheduled to approve the tax rate at the July 27th meeting. The tax bill file is scheduled to be prepared and sent to the printer on July 29th and bills will be in the mail by August 6th. The first quarterly payment is due by September 15th.
- The court ruling from the Judd v. City of Barre case hasn't been issued yet, and there's no further news about Mr. Judd's interest in filing an appeal to the VT Supreme Court.
- The utility arrearage assistance program is being offered again to help customers with delinquent water/sewer bills, however it is only available to residential renters who pay their water/sewer bills directly to the City. This will significantly limit the number of qualifying customers. Information about the program has been shared on FB, the website, and Front Porch Forum. To date there haven't been any applications.
- The City has posted information on Front Porch Forum and the website about the mortgage assistance program being offered by the state with COVID relief funds.

2. BUILDING AND COMMUNITY SERVICES:

- I checked on the pool and adjusted the water levels on Saturday, Sunday and Monday over the holiday weekend.
- I attended the Department Head meeting on Tuesday.
- The Aldrich Library held their children's Story Hour in Currier Park on Tuesday.
- On Tuesday evening, the summer high school basketball league had a game in the AUD.
- The DMV held CDL testing on Wednesday in the Civic Center parking lot.
- I participated in the pool project Zoom meeting on Wednesday.
- The Aldrich Library held another story hour event on Thursday in Currier Park.
- I met with a family on Thursday regarding the approval of a monument to be placed on their lot in Hope Cemetery.
- The Barre Partnership's "Concerts in the Park" and "Food Truck Thursday" events were moved to the BOR from Currier Park due to the weather. The food trucks all sold out of their products and there was a large crowd in attendance to listen to Tim Brick!
