

**Regular Meeting of the Barre City Council
Held March 31, 2020**

The Regular Meeting of the Barre City Council was called to order in person by Mayor Lucas Herring at 7:00 PM at Barre City Hall. In attendance, participating via video or phone conference, were: From Ward I, Councilors Jake Hemmerick and John Steinman; from Ward II, Councilors Michael Boutin and Teddy Waszazak; and from Ward III, Councilors Rich Morey and Ericka Reil. Also present via video or phone conference were City Manager Steve Mackenzie (arrived 7:08 PM), Finance Director Dawn Monahan, Human Resources Director Rikk Taft (arrived 7:12 PM), and Clerk/Treasurer Carol Dawes (arrived 7:10 PM).

Round Table –

Councilors thanked Barre Partnership executive director Tracie Lewis, who is using social media to remind the public of downtown businesses that are open. They also thanked those who are offering mutual aid in local communities, and noted the positivity messages being posted on the City's digital sign. Central Vermont Regional Planning Commission's website has a list of what different communities are doing to support their residents and businesses.

City Manager's Report - Manager Mackenzie reported on the following:

- Continuing negotiations on the pool refurbishment project. Expect to bring a final bid to Council for approval at next week's meeting.
- The USDA grant application was submitted today for the Wheelock House accessibility ramp.
- Participated in a zoom call with other municipal managers throughout the state on COVID-19. Most find themselves dealing with similar issues as are being addressed in Barre City.
- The winter parking ban ends tonight at 1:00 AM.

Councilor Hemmerick requested copies of the documents associated with the appeal of the Development Review Board's recent Salvation Army decision. Manager Mackenzie will get copies to all Councilors.

The City Clerk/Treasurer Report –

Old Business –

A) COVID-19 City Response Update, Discussion and/or Action.

Manager Mackenzie said Deputy Fire Chief Joe Aldsworth has been named as liaison to the emergency response center being coordinated by Capstone Community Action. Department heads are conducting thrice-weekly Advisory Task Force phone conferences on the City’s COVID-19 responses and operational protocols related to Governor Scott’s Stay Home Stay Safe order.

B) COVID-19 Update Re: FY20 Revenue Impacts & Year-end Deficit Projection.

Finance Director Dawn Monahan reviewed her revised FY20 projections, and said the projected revenue shortfall is approximately \$400,000. Ms. Monahan said the Manager and she have been working with all department heads to identify cost cutting and freeze measures, and she is now projecting a year end deficit of approximately \$200,000. All staff will continue to work on identifying additional adjustments. There was discussion on the impact on the already negative fund balance, reasons for high Police Department overtime, and pension obligations.

New Business –

A) Authorize Award of Municipal Pool Bid.

This item is deferred.

B) Ratification of Collective Bargaining Agreement with Local #4-68 of the USW.

This item is deferred.

C) Consideration/Action re: Extending Overnight Parking Permits COVID-19 Conditions.

Clerk Dawes reminded Councilors of their action from a couple weeks ago when they approved allowing overnight parking permits to be treated as 24 hour permits. That action runs through this Friday, April 3rd. The Clerk suggested extending the approval for an additional time as determined by the Council. There was discussion on the appropriate length of time for an extension.

Council approved extending their decision on overnight parking permits through May 30, 2020 on motion of Councilor Morey, seconded by Councilor Waszazak. **Motion carried on roll call vote, with Councilor Steinman voting against.**

D) Approve Interim Policy re: Waiver of Meter Fees, Collections and Enforcement.

Manager Mackenzie recommended Council place a moratorium on parking meter fees, collections and enforcement through May 30, 2020. The Manager said parking enforcement will still be in effect for other parking violations including parking in a handicap space or by a fire hydrant. Council approved the moratorium on motion of Councilor Morey, seconded by Councilor Reil. **Motion carried on roll call vote, with all voting in favor.**

E) Approval of COVID-19 Employee Sick/Quarantine Leave Payroll Policy.

Manager Mackenzie and Human Resources Director Rikk Taft reviewed the federal and state guidelines memo shared with employees after Governor Scott's issuance of the Stay Home Stay Safe order. There was discussion on access to federal emergency sick leave pay, unemployment, use of earned time, isolation order definitions, reimbursements from federal funds, and requirements for a doctor's note to return to work.

Councilor Boutin made the motion to approve the memo as presented as policy. The motion was seconded by Councilor Steinman. Councilor Waszazak made the motion to amend by removing the doctor's note requirement. The motion to amend died for lack of a second.

There was additional discussion on allowing staff more time to make adjustments to the document as they receive new information from the federal and state governments, and whether this is appropriately a policy.

Councilor Hemmerick offered a friendly amendment to the original motion to rename the document as "administrative guidance" rather than a policy. The original mover and seconder accepted the friendly amendment. **Original motion as amended carried on roll call vote, with all voting in favor.**

F) Approve Renaming Solid Waste Management Committee to Organic Diversion Committee.

Mayor Herring said the committee requested it be renamed to eliminate any confusion with Central Vermont Solid Waste Management District. Council approved renaming the committee on motion of Councilor Hemmerick, seconded by Councilor Steinman. **Motion carried on roll call vote, with all voting in favor.**

G) Tire collection day – CVSWMD Municipal Services Program Grants.

This item is deferred.

The Regular Meeting of the Barre City Council was called to order in person by Mayor Lucas Herring at 7:00 PM at Barre City Hall. Also present via video or phone conference were City Manager Steve Mackenzie, Public Works Director Bill Ahearn, Finance Director Dawn Monahan, and Clerk/Treasurer Carol Dawes.

Adjustments to the Agenda: Manager Mackenzie asked to add a COVID-19 update under old business. Such an update will be included on the weekly agendas until further notice. Councilor Hemmerick asked that the COVID-19 update include a discussion on frequency of financial reporting updates.

The City Clerk/Treasurer Report – Clerk/Treasurer Dawes reported on the following:

- The Clerk’s office is closed to the public, but staff is providing service via phone, web and email. Water & sewer bills, taxes, dog licenses and parking tickets can be paid on-line through a link on the City website. All bills and fees can also be paid by mail, or dropped in the drop box next to the front door of City Hall.
- Dog licenses are available, and the deadline has been extended from April 1st to May 1st.
- Water/sewer bills are due by March 31st. However, no late fees or interest charges will accrue during the month of April on any delinquent water/sewer bill.
- No late fees or interest charges will accrue on delinquent property tax bills from March 18th – April 15th.

Liquor Control – NONE

City Manager’s Report - Manager Mackenzie reported on the following:

- Will bring to Council for approval next week an interim policy regarding parking meters and enforcement under the current emergency circumstances.
- Negotiations are ongoing for the municipal pool project. The Manager said moving forward with both the base project and the beach entry will likely require reallocation of funds in the \$1.7 million bond approved by voters at the March 3, 2020 annual town meeting. He asked for input from Councilors. After a brief discussion, Council voiced support to continue with the negotiations and possible reallocation of funds.

Visitors and Communications – NONE

Old Business –

A) Approval of Authorization to Conduct Tax Sales.

Clerk Dawes said this is an annual authorization approved by Council to conduct tax sales during the year. In light of the virtual Council meeting, the Clerk asked that the approval include authorizing Mayor Herring to sign the authorization on behalf of the Council. Council approved the authorization and empowered the Mayor to sign on behalf of the Council on motion of Councilor Boutin, seconded by Councilor Reil. **Motion carried on roll call vote with all voting in favor.**

B) Ratify Council Actions re. COVID-19 Response: Dog Licenses, Parking Permits, Delinquent Bills Interest and Late Fees.

Clerk Dawes reminded Council of last week's actions, when the Council approved extending the dog license late fees to May 1st, allowing those with overnight parking permits to park during the day through April 3rd, and waiver of late fees and interest charges for thirty days on delinquent water & sewer bills and property tax payments. Council ratified last week's actions on motion of Councilor Waszazak, seconded by Councilor Hemmerick. **Motion carried on roll call vote with all voting in favor.**

New Business –

A) Authorization to Accept FY20 GHSP eticket subgrant for Barre City PD.

Council approved accepting the grant on motion of Councilor Steinman, seconded by Councilor Hemmerick. **Motion carried on roll call vote with all voting in favor.**

B) Authorization to Apply for the SRF loan for WWTF Improvements.

Public Works Director Bill Ahearn said the loan will cover costs associated with design and engineering services for the wastewater treatment facility improvements project. If construction is completed, the loan will be forgiven. The project involves replacing one digester cover, the boiler, and gas flare.

Council approved the application on motion of Councilor Morey, seconded by Councilor Boutin. **Motion carried on roll call vote with all voting in favor.**

C) Authorization to Execute Step II DuBois & King, Inc. Design Phase Agreement for WWTF Improvements.

Manager Mackenzie said the agreement with Dubois & King is the design and engineering services covered by the SRF loan approved in the previous agenda item. The cost of the agreement is equal to the value of the loan. There was discussion on the bid process, and it was noted Dubois & King was previously selected through a qualified bid selection more than a year ago.

Council approved execution of the agreement on motion of Councilor Steinman, seconded by Councilor Reil. **Motion carried on roll call vote with all voting in favor.**

D) Authorization to Purchase DPW Truck Chassis.

DPW Director Ahearn said this item will be covered out of the \$1.7 million bond recently approved by the voters. It has been selected for first purchase out of the items included in the bond because of a favorable state price and availability.

Council approved the purchase on motion of Councilor Waszazak, seconded by Councilor Morey. **Motion carried on roll call vote with all voting in favor.**

Added) COVID-19 Response Update, Discussion and/or Action.

Manager Mackenzie said Governor Scott just issued his "Stay at Home" order late this afternoon, and the

staff will look to implement its plans for compliance. There has been discussion on work at home options and what services are essential. In an effort to reduce the need for staff time in the offices, all payroll is being transitioned to direct deposit. All playgrounds and recreation facilities are closed. An interim purchase order process has been implemented for purchases over \$500. The Manager said Finance Director Dawn Monahan has been working on revised FY20 end-of-year projections, based on potential lost revenues due to the COVID-19 response. Preliminary projections show a year-end deficit of approximately \$400,000. The Manager said he will have a draft payroll policy next week.

Councilor Hemmerick requested more frequent financial reports, especially during the COVID-19 situation. He requested monthly updates. Manager Mackenzie said the intention is to present an update at next week's meeting.

Councilor Morey asked to hear from the Police Department about what safety measures are being taken by officers during interactions with the public.

Round Table –

Councilor Reil asked people with disabilities to reach out to local disability services during the COVID-19 situation.

Councilors reminded the public to remember those who are isolated, to offer support to our neighbors, practice social distancing, and support local businesses.

Mayor Herring reviewed the agenda for next week, and reminded people to go to trusted sources for COVID-19 updates. The Mayor said in light of current virtual meetings, the Council will review the policy and procedures for meetings.

Executive Session – NONE

The Council meeting adjourned at 8:06 PM on motion of Councilor Reil, seconded by Councilor Boutin. **Motion carried on roll call vote, with all voting in favor.**

2. Council asked if they have concerns. If so those applications are discussed and voted on separately;
3. All other applications recommended for approval in one motion;
4. Clerk affixes label to approved applications and mails to DLC.



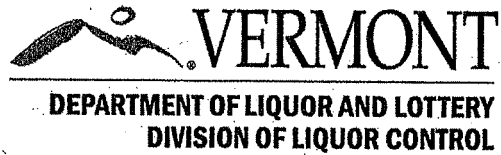



SUBJECT: TIME TRACKING and LEAVE POLICY FOR COVID-19 RESPONSE

It is the intent of Rikk Taft and myself to provide the best possible guidance we can regarding recent the Federal and State mandates, as well as responsive City Policy, during these “fluid” and unsettling times surrounding the COVID-19 crisis. Management is continuing to make decisions and provide guidance under rapidly changing circumstances, so this is the best information/guidance we have at this time. It is certainly subject to change, refinement or clarification as we proceed with implementation.

Please note: The Governor’s “Stay Home” Order is effective 5:00 p.m. today through April 15th. The Federal Mandates herein regarding leave reimbursement are not effective until April 2, so there is a **5 working-day gap** between the two. This guidance may change or be updated depending on any decisions by the Governor regarding his Stay Home Order as we approach or get to April 1th. In addition, any portion of this s guidance not Federally or State mandated, but reflecting City Administration policy is subject to Council approval at its March 31, 2020 meeting.

Invariably, one-size does not fit all, and there may be situations with individual employees with extenuating circumstances affecting certain aspects of this guidance. In such cases, the Manager will make final determinations of applicability on a case-by-case basis. Definitions

- a. Families First Coronavirus (COVID-19) Response Act (FFCRA):**
Legislation from the federal government H.R. 6201 enacted March 18, 2020
- b. Emergency Paid Sick Leave Act:** Division E of Families First Coronavirus (COVID-19) Response Act. Deals mostly with paid

leave time for people who are unable to work or work from home.

- c. **Emergency Family and Medical Leave Expansion Act:** Division C of Families First Coronavirus (COVID-19) Response Act. This is the expansion of Family and Medical Leave Act to include the closure of Schools and Childcare providers (Daycares, Child Care centers etc.)
- d. **Isolation:** The physical separation of ill persons from those who are not ill in order to prevent the spread of disease-causing germs.
- e. **Quarantine:** The physical separation of persons who have been exposed to assess whether they develop viral symptoms.
- f. **Social distancing:** staying at least a 6 feet away from other people. This may include:
 - cancelation of public gatherings, sporting events, meeting etc.
 - May include working from home rather than in the traditional office setting.
 - Closing of schools, daycares and care facilities.
 - Using electronic media to communicate and avoiding face to face contact
- g. **Close contact:** For the purpose of this program, close contact is defined as 6 feet or less from another person or in an area contaminated by their respirations.
- h. **Vulnerable** – Vulnerable will be used as defined by the CDC as at higher risk. This currently listed adults over the age of 65, pregnant women, and those with heart disease, lung disease or diabetes.
- i. **Stay at Home/ Shelter in Place:** This is sometimes referred to as Shelter in place. Shelter in place orders are traditionally used by local officials during or immediately after an emergency, like a mass shooting, chemical spill, or natural disaster. Lately politicians have been using the two terms synonymously.
 - **Stay at Home:** This is an order from the government, Local, State or Federal mandating residents stay in their homes and limit travel to essential trips, like picking up groceries, going to the bank, or receiving medical care. Some shelter in place orders have provisions permitting residents to walk or exercise outside in public spaces, so long as they stay 6 feet

away from others.

- **Shelter in Place:** Shelter in place orders generally close all nonessential businesses and prohibit their employees from leaving their homes to work, though the definition of “essential” businesses can vary depending on the specifics of the order.

- Blueish lips or face

CITY OF BARRE GUIDELINES TO STAFF

1. At any time if you are told to contact your medical provider or determine that you need to contact your medical provider, please ask for documentation as to their recommendations. This can be faxed to Human Resources 802-476-0264.
2. COVID-19 could gain entrance to a facility via infected employees. Staff should be educated to stay home if they display any of the symptoms.
3. Employees should consult their health care provider by telephone should they experience any symptoms.
4. If employees become sick at work, they should be advised to promptly report this to their supervisor and go home.
5. If employees have been exposed to a known COVID-19 case as defined by the VTDOH. Employees should be seeking medical attention from their primary care doctor.
6. Each Department Head will ensure payroll information is tracked

regarding any employee that is sick or in home quarantine.

7. During the COVID-19 outbreak (as at all times), staff are required to follow usual reporting rules for notifying their chain of command when they will be away from work due to illness or potential exposure.
8. For the wellbeing of all staff employees are required to take their temperature prior to coming into the office. If you have a temperature above 99.6 degrees you will be required to contact your department head or Human Resources and advise them of your status.

EMERGENCY PAID SICK LEAVE ACT (Division E)

The City of Barre under this Act will provide paid sick leave for Coronavirus (COVID-19)-related absences that are not covered under existing employer-provided paid sick leave programs.

Leave Reasons: The employer must provide employees with employer-paid sick time to the extent that employees are unable to work or telework due to a need for leave because:

TABLE 1

1.	the employee is subject to a federal, state or local quarantine or isolation order related to COVID-19;
2.	the employee has been advised by a health care provider to self-quarantine due to concerns related to COVID-19;
3.	The employee is experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 and is seeking a medical diagnosis;
4.	the employee is caring for an individual who is subject to an isolation or quarantine or has been advised to self-quarantine;
5.	the employee is caring for a son or daughter due to closure of school or place of care, or the childcare provider is unavailable;
6.	or the employee is experiencing any other similar condition specified by the Secretary of Health and Human Services (HHS) in consultation with the Secretary of the Treasury and the Secretary of Labor.

Compensation Required for Paid Sick Leave:

- It differs depending on the need for leave. The leave is paid at the employee's regular rate of pay for reasons 1, 2 or 3 above with a cap of \$511 per day and \$5,110 over the 80 Hours.
- For leave taken for reasons, 4, 5 and 6 above the compensation is two-thirds of the employee's regular rate of pay with a cap of \$200 per day and \$2,000 over the 80 Hours.

Paid Leave Available under this ACT: Full-time employees of covered employers are entitled to up to 80 hours of emergency paid sick leave; part-time employees of covered employers are entitled to an amount of emergency paid sick leave up to the average number of hours they work over a two-week period. This paid sick time does not carry over into the year 2021.

This leave is in addition to any other paid time off the employer already offers to employees. Employers may not require an employee to use other paid leave before they use the paid sick leave provided under the Emergency Paid Sick Leave Act.

Effective date: April 2, 2020 (15 days after March 18, 2020 enactment)

Expiration: Provisions expire on December 31, 2020.

EMERGENCY FAMILY AND MEDICAL LEAVE (FML) EXPANSION ACT (Division C)

What is FMLA? The Family and Medical Leave Act (FMLA) is a labor law requiring larger employers to provide employees unpaid leave for serious family health issues. Such qualified medical and family reasons may include adoption, pregnancy, foster care placement, family or personal illness, or military leave. It also provides for continuation of health insurance coverage and job protection. The FMLA is intended to provide families with the time and resources to deal with family emergencies, while also guiding employers..

The Expansion of FMLA (H.R. 6201)

Closed schools/childcare providers: Employees who are unable to work or tele-work due to the need for leave to care for a son or daughter under the age of 18 if the school (elementary or secondary) or place of care has been closed or the childcare provider of such son or daughter is unavailable due to a public health emergency. A public health emergency is an emergency with respect to COVID-19 declared by a federal, state or local authority.

Modifies definition of Covered Employer: The City of Barre is a covered employer under the provisions of this ACT.

Expands definition of Eligible Employee: Emergency provisions apply to employees who have been employed for at least 30 calendar days by the employer.

Creates potential exclusion of health care providers and emergency responders: Legislation grants the DOL power to exclude health care providers and emergency responders from the definition of eligible employee.

Employer obligations for payment:

- **The first 10 days** of the 12-week FMLA leave period may be unpaid leave, during which time an employee may substitute (but may not be compelled to take) accrued vacation, personal, medical or sick leave.
- **After the first 10 days of leave**, the employer shall provide paid leave for each day at a rate not less than 2/3 of regular rate of pay for the number of hours the employee would normally be scheduled to work. ~~You can use your accrued City benefits time to make up the difference if you wish~~-(Strikeout 3/27/20; Unemployment Reg's **do not allow** this. SEM)

For those employees with varying work schedules, the number of hours should be based upon the average number of hours scheduled over the previous six-month period or the reasonable expectation of hours at time of hire. In no event will the benefit amount for paid leave exceed \$200 per day and \$10,000 in the aggregate.

Notice: The employee should provide notice of the need for leave as soon as practicable.

Documentation: Documentation will be required and may include (1) recommendation from a public health official or health care provider that relevant employee has symptoms or should be quarantined; (2) documentation or evidence of exposure; or (3) notice of school or childcare provider closure.

Job Restoration: Employees are entitled to reinstatement to the same position or an equivalent position.

Effective date: April 2, 2020 (15 days after March 18, 2020 enactment)

Expiration: Provisions expire on December 31, 2020.

WORKING FROM HOME (Tele-Work)

The City realizes that every staff member plays a crucial role to the success of the municipality. Work Tasks will be evaluated using the following criteria:

1. Is the task essential to the continued operations of the City?

2. Can the task be completed from remote locations (home)?
3. What personnel are capable of doing the tasks?
4. Could alternate work plans be developed if employees have essential tasks but, are not able to complete the tasks remotely?

Working from home will be authorized for the following reasons:

- Federal, State or Local Government issue a stay at home order.
- The City Manager may elect to have some people work remotely to reduce the number of staff working in an office and help reduce the potential for exposure
- An employee that has essential duties communicates through their department head that they have one of the following scenarios
 - Child or Children that are out of School or daycare facilities do to government mandated closures or emergency closures due to weather or other emergency.
 - Employee has another person in their household that has been identified as vulnerable or to have a compromised immune system.
 - Employee has been told to self-quarantine due to their potential exposure or the exposure of an immediate family member that has tested positive for COVID-19

WORKING IN THE OFFICE (under stay at Home order)

In cases where the employee has to come into work to complete essential tasks, the following guidelines will be used to reduce the risk of exposure.

- Staffing will be scheduled on alternate shifts to reduce the face to face contact. This schedule will be determined by the Department head.
- Employee will only work in their assigned area(s)
- Employee will be responsible for wiping down any shared equipment (copiers, Printers, Phones etc.) prior to using them.
- Employee will be responsible for wiping down any shared equipment that was used while in the place of work.
- Employees will not be allowed to enter the place of work while another employee is working in a space that puts the two employees in close contact.
- Employees should only come into the office on their allotted time slots.

TIME TRACKING

The City of Barre has created a COVID leave code for the purposes of tracking your time. On the time cards you will write in COVID and the hours unable to work or telework that meet the Criteria in **Table 1**.

1. Who can use COVID time code?

- A. All Employees can use the COVID code on time as long as the criteria above is met and your department head is aware.

2. What can COVID time code be used for?

- A. COVID can be used by employees in the following situations when the employee is unable to work or telework:

TABLE 1 (*Repeated from Page 4 for convenienc*)

<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. the employee is subject to a federal, state or local quarantine or isolation order related to COVID-19;2. the employee has been advised by a health care provider to self-quarantine due to concerns related to COVID-19;3. The employee is experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 and is seeking a medical diagnosis;4. the employee is caring for an individual who is subject to an isolation or quarantine or has been advised to self-quarantine;5. the employee is caring for a son or daughter due to closure of school or place of care, or the childcare provider is unavailable;6. or the employee is experiencing any other similar condition specified by the Secretary of Health and Human Services (HHS) in consultation with the Secretary of the Treasury and the Secretary of Labor.
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3. When is the COVID code available for use?

- A. COVID leave is available for use beginning April 2, 2020.
- B. Any hours when an employee is unable to work or telework as defined in **Table 1**. prior to April 2nd will be allocated to the employees accrued leave time (*Sick, Vacation, Comp, Etc.*). Sick leave may be elected first.

4. If an employee's absence qualifies for COVID leave, will they be required to use their own leave balances before using their other earned paid leave?

- A. No, COVID is to be used in place of earned paid leave (Sick, Annual, Personal, Compensatory Time). Please refer back to Item 3.A above.

5. What does self-isolation mean?

A. Per VDH guidelines, self-isolation due to COVID -19 is defined as being personally symptomatic, caring for symptomatic family members, likely to have been exposed, or, personal underlying health conditions.

6. Can eligible employees use COVID without first communicating with their supervisor?

A. No, employees must communicate with their supervisor before using COVID

7. Can employees who are authorized to telework use COVID?

A. Employees who are authorized to telework are expected to work and would not use COVID unless prevented from teleworking for one of the reasons discussed below.

8. Can an employee who is not sick but has been quarantined or recommended to self-isolate use COVID?

A. Yes, if they are unable to work from home.

9. Can an employee who is staying home because of concerns with their own underlying health condition use COVID?

A. Yes, if they are unable to Work from Home and their underlying health condition(s) have been identified by VDH as making them more susceptible to COVID-19. Medical documentation may be required.

10. Can an employee who is working from home and has children at home due to school and/or childcare facility closures use COVID?

A. Possibly. Employees who are teleworking should communicate with their supervisors about the feasibility of flexing their workday to allow for working from home. Existing/normal Time Reporting Codes should be used for hours spent working from home . Hours these employees are NOT able to tele-work due to time spent caring for the children who would have been attending school, childcare and/or an after-school program would code COVID.

11. Can an employee who is not able to work from Home and has children at home due to school and/or childcare facility closures use COVID?

A. Yes, for any hours they would have worked during which the child would

have been attending school, childcare and/or an after-school program.

12. Can an employee who is filling in for an immediate family member, to provide childcare, whose children are home due to school and/or childcare facility closures use COVID?

A. Yes, for any hours they would have worked during which the child would have been attending school, childcare and/or an after-school program.

13. Can an employee who comes to work but is sent home by management for COVID-19 related reasons use COVID?

A. Yes, if they are unable to work from home

14. Can an employee who has been authorized to work from home, who is not sick; not in self-isolation; does not have an underlying health condition, but doesn't want to work use COVID?

A. No, an employee in this situation would have to request approval from their supervisor to use discretionary leave (Vacation, Personal, Compensatory Time)

15. Will employees be required to provide medical documentation to support their use of COVID?

A. Yes, and employees should anticipate supervisors and/or Human Resources asking clarifying questions. The **exception** would be where employees are home to take care of children under the FMLA exemptions as defined above.

16. Can an employee, who is authorized to telework, who has an underlying health condition(s), for which self- isolation is recommended, use COVID?

A. Yes, for any hours they are unable to Work from Home.

17. Can employees, whose positions do not support telework, who have underlying health condition(s), for which self-isolation is recommended, use COVID?

A. Yes, these employees can utilize COVID.

18. Can an employee , who is authorized to telework, who resides with someone

who has an underlying health condition(s), but does not require care, for which self-isolation is recommended, use COVID?

A. No.

19. Is COVID leave "good time" for overtime?

A. No, COVID is not considered as time actually worked for overtime eligibility.

20. Will COVID impact my sick leave accruals?

A. No, COVID will not negatively impact leave accruals.

21. Will an employee's original probationary period be extended due to the use of COVID?

A. Yes.

22. Can Part Time employees use COVID?

A. Yes, if they meet one of the scenarios described above.

B. Part time employees with a regular schedule would code COVID for any regularly scheduled hours they would have otherwise worked.

23. Use of COVID leave for office absences prior to April 2nd?

A. The City will allow the use of accrued leave (Sick, Vacation, Comp) time in order to continue compensating staff until we reach the April 2nd effective date.

PAYROLL

Time cards – We will be sending out more guidance on this shortly.

Fire/EMS, Police and Meters timecards will remain the same. The timecards will be scanned and sent electronically to Bonnie. Bonnie will then forward her spreadsheet(s) to Donna and CC: Dawn and the respective Department head. (Tim for Police and Doug for Fire)

City Hall Staff- Employees will complete the new electronic time cards and submit them to their supervisors. Department heads will review and forward to Donna and Dawn.

Department Heads – Department Heads will use the new electronic timecards and submit them to the Manager for review. The Manager will sign the timecards electronically and forward to Donna and Dawn.

DPW Staff – Employees will submit their time cards to the foreperson or chief operator as directed. The foreperson or chief operator will photograph and submit for processing. (Submission point is undetermined at this time)

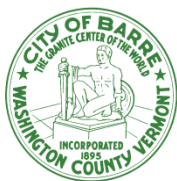

In order to keep you informed of the Department activities of the office, I'm forwarding this report of activities of the City staff for the previous Friday - Thursday. If there are any additional questions please do not hesitate to ask.

1. CLERK/TREASURER'S OFFICE:

- City Hall is completely closed to the public. Staff are working staggered days and the office is covered reduced hours. We are prioritizing processing payments and making deposits at the bank to ensure we can continue to meet payroll and pay our bills.
- Liquor license expirations have been extended from April 30th to June 30th. We will continue to process renewals as they come in.
- Annual unclaimed property reporting is ongoing. The report is due to the VT Treasurer's Unclaimed Property Division by May 1st. I haven't heard of an extension on this deadline.
- Voter-approved charter changes have been submitted to the Secretary of State's office, however, the statehouse is now on restricted access, and this will likely affect legislation for the balance of the session. We'll have to wait and see.
- We continue to process dog license renewals, mostly through the mail and online payments. The modified system seems to be working well. Council extended late fees to May 1st.
- Water & sewer bill payments are due by March 31st, with waiver of late fees and interest charges for the following 30 days. Payments are being received through the mail and online payments. The modified system is working well.
- An RFP for a bond anticipation note was issued last week, and responses are due by April 6th. This would allow us to set up a line of credit for the \$1.7M bond approved by the voters on Town Meeting Day.

- The legislature is considering emergency legislation that will change the current Open Meeting Law to allow virtual public meetings without the requirement of a physical location available to the public. There is also emergency legislation being considered to make changes to election law, should the COVID-19 situation continue into the summer election season. Extensions have been put in place for a number of statutory deadlines including liquor license expirations, income tax filing deadlines and homestead declaration/property tax rebate filing deadlines. There is ongoing of the impact these extensions will have on a municipality's ability to issue property tax bills, and expansion of abatement criteria to make it easier for property owners to request abatement of taxes for financial hardship.

2. BUILDING AND COMMUNITY SERVICES:

- Met with the Vermont Health Department, CVMC, Chief Brent and Deputy Chief Aldsworth and the Vermont National Guard on Monday morning to plan and set up the Medical Surge unit in the AUD basement.
- Participated in COVID 19 conference calls with other City staff on Monday, Wednesday and Friday.
- Attended pre-bid site visit at the pool with vendors for the “hydro – blasting”/ sand – blasting project. Three prospective bidders attended.
- Participated in Department Head conference call on Tuesday.
- Met with the BCS staff on Tuesday afternoon regarding the Governor's “Stay Home – Stay Safe” directive. Four staff members are now out on leave and Stephanie is working from home.
- Spoke to one of the local Funeral Parlors regarding burials and how the Governor's order affects them. After conferring with Carol it was deemed best to not conduct “grave side services” at this time.
- Participated in a Pool Project conference call on Thursday.
- Friday I received and reviewed the bids for the hydro/sand blasting project for the pool. We received four bids and I will make my recommendation to the Council.
- Don had one entombment at the Elmwood vault on Monday. Tuesday Don had some plowing to do and the rest of the week was spent picking up winter debris.
- The Facilities crew finished sanitizing and closing up the AUD and BOR. They also cleaned the main room in Alumni Hall as well as the ground level. Some snow plowing was done on Tuesday.

2a. RECREATION:

- The week was filled with updates, conference calls, procedures, etc. pertaining to COVID-19
- Participated on a swimming pool conference call.
- Worked on cemetery burial counts – breakdown of months, type of burial
- Sorted through outdated files in the office.

- Set up laptop, etc. at home, communicated first day at home with other DH's figuring access to information, etc.
- Connected on the school meal distribution
- Connected with Vermont Recreation and Parks Association President.
- Following National Recreation and Parks Association on recommendations – keeping an eye on use of trails, etc. and any impact, etc.
- Updated Civic Center schedule
