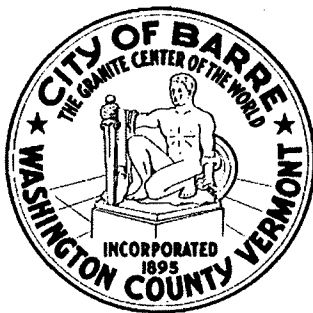



**CITY OF BARRE, VERMONT
