Article 1:

The Central Vermont Career Center School Board proposes to incur bonded indebtedness to expand access to Career and Technical Education in Central Vermont through a multi-campus model by building on the U-32 campus, at an estimated total project cost of **\$54,900,000**. The Vermont State Legislature suspended the School Construction Aid Program in 2007. Therefore, the school district must build 100% of the project at its own cost, without State participation. **State funds may not be available when this project would otherwise be eligible to receive State school construction aid. The district is responsible for all costs incurred in connection with any borrowing done in anticipation of State school construction aid.**
