BUILDING PERMIT APPLICATION

A Building Permit is required when there is construction, enlargement, alteration, relocation, demolition and Change of Use or Change in Occupancy of all structures within all areas of the City of Barre.

A Building Permit is not required when there is general maintenance and repair of structures, or the replacement of individual components, including but not limited to the replacement of roofs, doors and windows as long as the rough opening is not altered. Please call to discuss prior to any work commencing.

This is an application for a local permit only. State Permits may be NECESSARY. Please contact the Vermont Dept. of Public Safety at (802) 479-4434 for permitting requirements.

Fee for starting work without a permit is \$150

If work has begun prior to applying for and receiving a permit(s), you are in violation of City Ordinance and are required to pay \$150 after-the-fact fee in addition to the subtotal fee calculated at bottom.
