SUMMARY OF INCIDENT: On February 22, 2026, at approximately 1159 hours, Barre City Officers were dispatched to the North End Deli located at 475 North Main Street for a report of a robbery. It was alleged that a male subject had robbed the clerk and fled with an undisclosed amount of cash and two alcoholic drinks from the store. Through investigation and area video footage, it was determined that the subject had left the scene in a white Mercury Grand Marquis.

On February 28, 2026, the suspected vehicle utilized in the robbery was located parked unoccupied on Merchants Row. Barre Town Police K9 Officer, Corporal de Prato and K9 Lakota assisted by conducting an exterior sniff of the vehicle and subsequently alerted to the odor of narcotics from within the vehicle. The vehicle was subsequently seized and a warrant granted for a search of the vehicle. Evidence seized from the vehicle linked Stephen N. Davis to the robbery.

Davis is under the supervision of Burlington Probation and Parole. After Davis failed to report to his Probation and Parole Officer, an arrest warrant has been applied for Davis on the offenses of Assault and Robbery, Retail Theft, and Habitual Offender.

Coincidentally, Davis was previously arrested for an Assault and Robbery at the North End Deli Mart stemming from an incident on May 12, 2021.
