ELIGIBILITY AND GUIDELINES

Any person eighteen (18) years or older meeting the criteria listed below is eligible to participate in the Police Department's Ride-Along Program.

- A resident of the City of Barre, Vermont; or a:
 - Visiting law enforcement officer, individual with an interest in law enforcement, applicant for employment with, or an employee of the Barre City Police Department.
 - Relative of an active or retired Barre City Police Department employee.
 - Professional or college student in the field of Criminal Justice, Law, or the Social Sciences.
 - Member of an accredited news agency.
 - Governmental Official or an employee of the City of Barre.

Participation in this program is limited to once every six (6) months unless otherwise approved by the Commander, Patrol Division.

Students who are at least sixteen (16) years old are eligible to participate in conjunction with a work-study program sponsored by the Barre Unified Union School District or other school district. The student must also have written permission from his/her parent or legal guardian to participate in the Barre City Police Department Ride-Along Program.

- Student participants that have not reached their 18th birthday must be approved by the Chief, or Deputy Chief of Police.
- Unless otherwise approved by the Chief of Police or his/her designee, the term of the vocational ride-along shall not be more than four (4) occurrences over the specified range of the vocational program.

Only one (1) ride-along participant may accompany an officer at any given time.

The dress code for ride-along participants is casual clothing. However, the clothing must be appropriate (i.e., no shorts, tank tops, spandex, yoga pants, etc.).

Ride-along participants are prohibited from carrying or possessing weapons of any kind.

Tape recorders, cameras and video equipment by ride-along participants cannot be used without permission.

If the host officer's assignment requires entering a private residence or private property not open to the public, under no circumstances is a ride-along participant permitted to accompany the officer. This includes accompanying the officer to the door of the residence. The ride-along participant must either remain in the cruiser or on public property.

If the host officer is required to respond to a serious incident which may present a danger to a ride-along participant, the host officer must leave the participant at a safe location prior to responding to the incident.
