SUMMARY OF INCIDENT:

On December 28, 2024, at approximately 1pm Barre City Police responded to a report of a robbery from a person at the rear of 88 N. Main Street in Barre City. A 63-year-old male had exited a business on N. Main Street where he was followed to his vehicle by 33-year-old Carlos Perez of Barre. Perez allegedly asked the victim for money to buy kerosene. When the victim refused, Perez allegedly attacked the victim, throwing him to the ground. After a brief struggle, Perez ran off with the victim's wallet. The victim sustained a minor head injury and general soreness. Video surveillance of the incident yielded the identity of Perez. Perez was later located outside of a business in Berlin by a Montpelier officer and was taken into custody without incident. Perez was found to be in possession of .2 grams of crack cocaine. Perez was lodged in lieu of \$3500 bail and is due to appear in Washington Superior Court on December 30, 2024, to answer the charges of Assault and Robbery and Possession of Cocaine.
