- 1. The meeting was called to order by Chair, Renita Marshall at 6:30 pm
- 2. Adjustments to the Agenda
 - a. Three items were added to be discussed at Round Table:
 - i. Bus stops on Prospect Street
 - ii. Parking on Tomasi Street
 - iii. Temporary Parking on Washington Street
- 3. The visitors indicated they were not in attendance to bring topics to the attention of the Committee
- 4. Old Business:
 - a. Update on Speed Tables Ayers & Circle Streets
 - i. Ayers St.: After discussion about location, it was determined that the best location would be in the Kirk/Murray Street block
 - ii. Circle St.: After discussion about location, it was determined that the best location would be in the vicinity of the 90 Circle St. area
 - iii. ACTION: Bill Ahearn will ensure that the lighting and drainage requirements can be met in both locations
 - iv. ACTION: Bill Ahearn will reach out to property owners and tenants to update them as to the plan
 - v. ACTION: Bill Ahearn will update the Committee as to progress at next meeting
 - b. Update on crosswalks/temporary bulb-outs Merchant Street
 - i. Weather is impeding the crosswalk installation
 - ii. Temporary bulb-outs are still scheduled to be installed within two weeks as long as the weather cooperates
 - 1. The devices have been cast for the bulb-outs
 - 2. City staff have been in busy with the snow/ice and unable to complete due to schedules
 - 3. Two locations have been identified where there are existing crosswalks:
 - a. Near Midway Street

b. Near 26 Merchant Street

- c. Update on parking lot on Summer Street (previous discussion around access and parking lot alignment)
 - i. It was noted that the lot is referred to as the Pearl Street parking lot
 - ii. Due to weather, this is on hold
 - iii. If the weather cooperates by December 1, chances of paving are still possible
 - iv. If the weather does not cooperate, this will be on hold until spring
 - v. Exit curb cut has been completed on Pearl Street
- d. Review & Prioritze Backlog of Requests
 - i. After discussion it was decided to table these items until next month when the Committee could focus solely on the list

5. New Business

- a. No items have been requested that are not presently on the list of requests
- 6. Confirm next meeting date
 - a. The next regularly scheduled meeting of the Transportation Advisory Committee is Wednesday, December 18, 2019

7. Round Table

- i. Bus stops on Prospect Street
 - 1. Real Maurice expressed concern about the location of the bus stops on Prospect Street due to sight lines, incline and traffic delay
 - ACTION: Renita Marshall will reach out to the Barre City School Bus Coordinator to discuss further and report back at next meeting
- ii. Parking on Tomasi Street
 - 1. The City maintains a right of way on Tomasi Street
 - 2. Tomasi Street provides access to the loading dock of Walgreens
 - 3. There is one parking space on Tomasi Street, that when utilized, causes issues around access to the loading dock for Walgreen
 - 4. Bill Ahearn has received no less than 25 complaints about illegal parking on this street
 - 5. Bill Ahearn recommends eliminating the parking spot
 - 6. ACTION: Bill Ahearn will remove the parking spot, install no parking signs and speak to the potentially impacted business
- iii. Temporary Parking on Washington Street

- 1. Art Bombardier expressed concern about the width of Washington Street during the winter months if the temporary parking is allowed to remain
- 2. Bill Ahearn reports that the area is seeing significant use
- 3. Steve Mackenzie reports he does not want to make policy decisions for an issue that may or may not occur
- 4. Guest Michael Hellien supports the temporary parking locations remaining in place to provide a buffer between traffic and those utilizing the sidewalks
 - a. DECISION: No action will be taken at this time. If issues arise throughout the winter, it will be revisited.
- 5. Giuliano Cecchinelli mentioned that one parking spot near Spaulding Street seems to be in the way when exiting from Academy Street and turning up the hill of Washington Street
 - a. ACTION: Bill Ahearn will remove that parking spot
- 6. Railroad updates
 - a. Bill Ahearn has heard from the Railroad that they expect to put in signals at both the Berlin Street and South Main Street crossings
- 7. Stop sign request
 - a. Art Bombardier requested a stop sign be placed at Patterson Street/Hill Street
 - i. ACTION: Bill Ahearn will install stop sign
- 8. The meeting adjourned at 8:18pm
