Amanda: Recommends a simple setup for watering the nursery trees this summer: rain barrel on some blocks with a water spout for filling buckets. The City staff at the reservoir would be able to fill the barrel, as needed. Amanda believes a more elaborate setup could be designed and built later, but at this time the City has the available materials to put together a sufficient watering system for the nursery. Will discuss later with Jeff on the potential for this.
